Each year in Nepal, mountain porters suffer serious illness or die carrying loads to enable Western visitors to enjoy the mountains of Nepal.

As part of their work in the Gokyo Valley, the International Porter Protection Group (IPPG) and Community Action Nepal (CAN) are constructing a porter shelter in Gokyo Village where porters frequently have to cook and sleep without shelter at 4800 m. Regrettably work has had to stop on the project because of inadequate funds. £40,000 is required for its completion.
